



## TWO TYPES OF "CUTS"





### BEVEL SUPPORTED


- · CLEANLY CUTS WOOD FIBERS
- · CONTROLLED CUT
- · BETTER FINISH
- · THINK "BENCH PLANE"


### NON-BEVEL SUPPORTED

- . EDGE CONTACT ONLY
- · AGGRESSIVE
- · HARD TO CONTROL
- · LESS THAN I DEAL FINISH
- · CAN BE FASTER
- · ONLY CHOKE WHEN THERE IS NO SUFFACE TO SUPPORT THE BEVEL (ROUGHING)









### BOWL TURNING PROCESS

- · ROUGH TURN BLANK TO ROUND
- ·SHAPE OUTSIDE
- · MAKE TENON/FOOT
- · REVERSE CHUCK LEVEL TOP
- · HOLLOW INSIDE · ROUGH
- · HOLLOW INSIDE · FINISH CUTS
- · BOWL BOTTOM-INSIDE
- · REVERSE AGAIN+ FINISH FOOT
