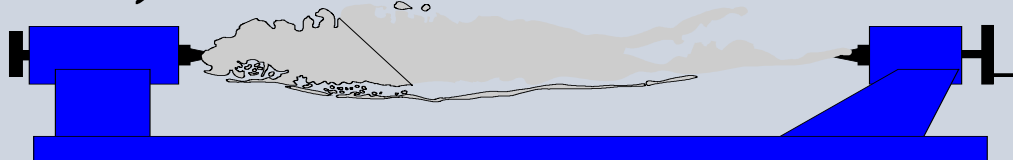

- OUTSIDE - EASY ACCESS
- INSIDE - LIMITED ACCESS
- OFTEN DISPLAYED AS DECORATIVE ITEM → VIEWED CRITICALLY

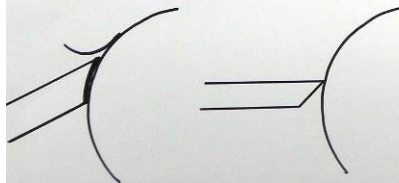

TWO TYPES OF "CUTS"

BEVEL SUPPORTED

- CLEANLY CUTS WOOD FIBERS
- CONTROLLED CUT
- BETTER FINISH
- THINK "BENCH PLANE"

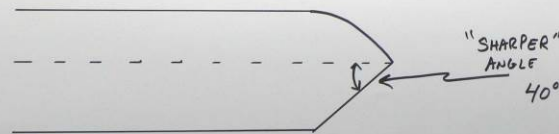
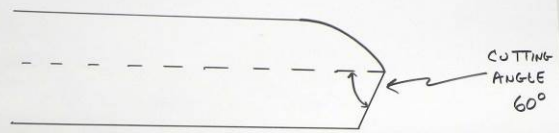


NON-BEVEL SUPPORTED

- EDGE CONTACT ONLY
- AGGRESSIVE
- HARD TO CONTROL
- LESS THAN IDEAL FINISH
- CAN BE FASTER
- ONLY CHOKE WHEN THERE IS NO SURFACE TO SUPPORT THE BEVEL (ROUGHING)

CUTTING ANGLES

STEEPER CUTTING ANGLE \Rightarrow MORE EFFICIENT CUT



FLUTE SHAPES

TRADITIONAL
