

- Our August meeting will be on the 20th at Steve Fulgoni's home, 29 White Birch Drive, Dix Hills at 9AM.






Show and Tell

No Show and tell this month

We normally do not have show and tell when professional turners are at the meeting, please bring all show and tell to Bob Urso's and Steve Fulgoni's house over the summer.



DEMONSTRATION - Spindle turning and basic woodturning techniques by Keith Tompkins.



Keith began his demo by showing some basic cuts with a roughing gouge and



emphasized riding the bevel for safe clean work. Start with the handle down and raise the tool until it begins to cut. He switched to a spindle gouge and showed the same technique keeping the tool at the center of the workpiece. He grinds the heel of the tool to create a secondary bevel which gives him greater clearance in tight spots.

Keith showed how he uses a skew to do a planning cut, make "V" cuts and to lay out beads. He turned a holiday ornament with a very thin finial and then turned a calabash bowl from some Hawaiian mango.
