On Saturday, May 21st, we had our first ever remote meeting (July and August meetings at Bob's and Steve's don't count - they're a regular thing). It was held at Singh Hardwood Co. in Far Rockaway. Not the easiest place to get to, but well worth the trip. Our host, Jay Singh, welcomed us and told something of his background.

Both he and his wife, who is a major part of the operation, were born in India, came here as children, but on opposite coasts. They met on a dating app and (obviously) clicked. They married and have 3 daughters, the oldest of whom is also part of the operation. Jay worked in the lumber business for many years before opening his current business 7 years ago.

Jay was kind enough to provide us with refreshments, and he gave us a tour of the place. One interesting piece of equipment was the moulding machine, which can surface all 4 sides of a piece of lumber in one operation, and can also create decorative mouldings, depending on which knife sets are used - and he has thousands of shapes!

This was not only a first for us, but also for Jay, who couldn't have been more accommodating and forthcoming. In addition to LIWA, we also invited the Long Island Woodworkers to the meeting, and several of that club also attended.

The operation is HUGE, and mostly indoors. Many attendees bought some exotic lumber, and many left with cut-offs that Jay invited us to raid, since they were going to throw them out anyway.

It was an interesting trip, a worthwhile trip, a profitable trip. Anyone from either club can order from Jay and get a discounted price on the purchase. He has a huge selection of lumber products, and what he doesn't have, he can get.


