Summary of Meeting

The meeting started with an introduction, raffle and show and tell. We encourage everyone to bring things they have made.

Ken's demonstration included something for everyone. Those of you who have difficulty sharpening bowl gouges or detail gouges were treated to a demonstration on methods for setting up your grinder and jig to get repetitive shape grinds. The second topic was the "Fair Curve" and how to get a shape that is eye catching. The third topic was hollowing. Similar to last month's demo on deep hollowing with a fixture but using more basic tools for simpler hollowing projects. The fourth was how to use indexing and finally carving flutes on a project, leveraging a handheld router and simple fixtures. It was noted that you need to know how deep you plan to carve the flute and leave sufficient wall thickness.
